STRY programme at College of Horticulture Bermiok



GANGTOK, NOV 27—The Skill Training of Rural Youth (STRY) programme on "Agricultural Sustainability with Beneficial Microbes in Organic Agriculture" was jointly organized by the Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA), Agriculture Department, Government of Sikkim, Namchi, Sikkim, and Multi-Technology Testing Centre and Vocational Training Centre (MTTC & VTC), College of Horticulture (CoH), Central Agricultural University (CAU) (Imphal), Bermiok, Sikkim, from November 21st to 27th, 2023, at the CoH, CAU

(Imphal) Bermiok, Sikkim. The programme was sponsored by MANAGE, Hyderabad, and Skill India Ltd., focused on imparting skills to school dropouts and youths. The inaugural event at the College of Horticulture, Bermiok, featured Ashok Chettri, Principal of Bermiok School, who was the chief guest. Dr. Nandam Chandra, Deputy Project Director ATMA, Agriculture Department, Namchi, Sikkim, and Dr. Ajai Kumar Pandey, Dean, CoH, Bermiok, were also present. Dr. Y. Rupert Anand, the programme coordinator, emphasized the significance of mi-

crobes in agriculture. Dr. Nandam Chandra highlighted ATMA's activities, emphasizing skill development of youths and farmers. Dr. A. K. Pandey, Dean, CoH, Bermiok, discussed sustainable agriculture and later gave a lecture on the role of microbes in sustainable agriculture. Ashok, the Principal, stressed the importance of developing skills in youths and highlighted the role of microbes in daily life. A training manual titled "Harnessing the Potential of Microbes for Sustainable Agriculture" was released during the programme. The training

sessions included lectures and hands-on training by various resource persons. Ms. Passang Dolma Bhutia, ADO, Agriculture Department, covered the production of biocontrol agents, while Dr. Sunil Kumar Chongtham, Assistant Professor, CoH, Bermiok, provided hands-on training on composting. Raju Pradhan, Farm Manager, CoH, Bermiok, demonstrated the preparation of homemade organic fertilizer. Nirma Dorjee, from Sikkim IFCO, gave a lecture on organic bio-products and also gave live demonstrations of their products. Dr. Y. Rupert Anand, Assistant Professor, CoH, Bermiok, demonstrated mushroom spawn production and cultivation, and Dr. S. Vinodh, Assistant Professor, CoH, Bermiok, gave a lecture on post-harvest production and hands-on flower post-harvest techniques. During the valedictory session, Ms. Saati Rai, Horticulture Inspector, Bermiok, Govt of Sikkim, and Ms. Passang, BTM, ATMA, Agriculture Department, Govt. Sikkim, were the guests of honor. They congratulated the participants and distributed training certificates. Pea and onion seeds were distributed on the first and last days of the programme. Pandian visits Jagannath Temple and Tara Tarini Peeth on joining BJD

BERHAMPUR, NOV 27—After formally joining the ruling BJD on Monday, former bureaucrat VK Pandian visited Maa Tara Tarini temple, one of the famous Shakti shrines in Ganjam district, and performed a puja.

The 49-year-old new generation leader, chairman of ST (transformational initiative) and Nabin (new) Odisha programme, also visited Shree Jagannath Temple in Puri before formally joining the BJD. Hundreds of party functionaries and supporters, Aska MP Pramila Bisoi, Berhampur mayor Saughamitra Dalei and a number of MLAs thronged the Tara Tarini temple to welcome Pandian into the party fold. He was accompanied by the party's organising secretary Pranab Prakash Das and some other legislators. Maa Tara Tarini, the twin goddess, are the presiding deities of Ganjam. Pandian is attached to the temple since his days as the district collector of Ganjam from 2007 to 2011. He joined as the private secretary to the chief minister in 2011 and worked for 12 years till he retired from government service on October 23, 2023.

Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik also visits the Shakti shrine every time before filing nominations from Hindu assembly constituency. "He is one of the devotees of Maa Tara Tarini and visits the place very frequently. Like other days, he also visited today and spent around 15 minutes to perform rituals and seeking blessings of the Goddess," said a priest of the temple. Maa Tara Tarini temple development was the state government's initiative for transformation of pilgrims' amenities in temples under Pandian's supervision. The transformation work that started in the shrine has been taken up across the state in several other temples, said R.Ch. (PTI)

Delhi University may provide up to 20 per cent courses online through Swayam portal

NEW DELHI, NOV 27—The Delhi University may provide up to 20 per cent of its courses through online medium on the Swayam portal.

A proposal in this regard will be placed before the Academic Council during its meeting scheduled for November 30.

According to the proposal, colleges may consider to provide up to 20 per cent of the total courses being offered in a semester programme in a semester in online mode.

This would supplement the teaching-learning process in the institute, the proposal said.

The proposal is expected to be opposed by a large majority of AC members who feel that employment generation at the university will be at risk amid the push for online learning, according to Maya John, assistant professor, Jesus Mary college.

"Almost 90 per cent of the Academic Council members will oppose this proposal as it is an anti-student and anti-teacher move. Classroom teach-

ing is very important for many students who come from different backgrounds and this will also impact the need for teaching staff who will be substituted by online learning on Swayam," she said. The proposal is in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 that aims to achieve 50 per cent Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education by year 2035 with the help of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) offered by the Swayam platform.

The Academic Council in June 2019 had sought the Executive Council's approval for the adoption of the UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses) through

SWAYAM Regulations, 2016.

Earlier this year, the university's Department of Commerce had expressed its desire to implement MOOCs developed by teachers of the department and develop its course content based on the curriculum of the university.

A Departmental Council meeting in February had decided and approved details regarding the title of the MOOC to be offered, its course coordinator, and credits to be assigned for the same.

Currently, Delhi University does not provide MOOCs through Swayam—a government portal for free online courses for students. (PTI)

MHRC seeks report from the Government pertaining to non-payment of salaries for 3 years: One out of six staff members dies

SHILLONG, NOV 27—The Meghalaya Human Rights Commission (MHRC) has taken suo motu cognizance of a news report pertaining to the non-payment of salaries of contractual employees of the transport department in South Garo Hills District. The MHRC has issued a Notice to the Chief Secretary, Government of Meghalaya, to look into the entire matter and submit a detailed report to the Commission within 15 days. This was revealed by the Secretary, Meghalaya Human Rights Commission. (DIPR)

2-day Punjab Assembly session begins today, likely to be a stormy affair

CHANDIGARH, NOV 27—The two-day Punjab Assembly session, which begins on Tuesday, is likely to be a stormy affair with the opposition parties trying to corner the AAP government over several issues, including law and order, illegal sand mining and the state's debt.

During the session, the Bhagwant Mann government will table three Money Bills—the Punjab Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (Amendment) Bill, 2023, the Punjab Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2023, and the Indian Stamp (Punjab Amendment) Bill, 2023.

Another Bill, the Punjab Canal and Drainage Bill, 2023, is also likely to be tabled in the House. The Bill aims to regulate and manage canals and drainage in the state.

The session will start

with obituary references on Tuesday, said officials. Punjab Governor Ranwarlal Puri had summoned the two-day session of the state Assembly.

The opposition parties have slammed the AAP government for holding the session for a short duration. "When the last session ended abruptly, the chief minister assured that in the next session in November, enough time will be given to the opposition to discuss the issues of Punjab," said Leader of Opposition in the Punjab Assembly Partap Singh Bajwa.

"I want to ask the CM why he was scared," said Bajwa.

"The present government has a lot to hide," the Congress leader alleged as he slammed the AAP government for calling the session just for two days.

"Though they have 92

MLAs in the House, they do not have the strength to face the opposition," said Bajwa while speaking to reporters in Chandigarh.

When AAP was in the opposition, it used to raise a "hue and cry" that not enough time was given to the opposition in the House, he said, demanding at least 10 sittings of the House for a detailed discussion.

Bajwa said there are several issues like the law and order situation, drugs problem, illegal sand mining, the state's debt and "poor" fiscal situation which need to be discussed in the House. Meanwhile, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, while addressing a gathering in Dhuri, slammed the opposition parties for

"not having any issue" to raise. "Tomorrow, the Vidhan Sabha session will start. Many Bills will be brought in the House," said Mann.

The governor summoned the session after he prorogued the Budget Session held in March.

The issue of summoning the session by extending the Budget Session by the AAP government was a sore point between the Bhagwant Mann dispensation and the Raj Bhavan.

On November 10, the Supreme Court had pulled up the Punjab governor for "indefinitely sitting over" some Bills passed by the Assembly. "You are playing with fire," it had remarked.

The apex court had also questioned the state government for repeatedly adjourning the Budget Session sine die instead of proroguing it. It, however, upheld the Speaker's supremacy in conducting the business of the House or adjourning its sessions. (PTI)

MUMBAI, NOV 27—Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar on Monday described Mahatma Gandhi as the mahapurush of the last century, and termed Prime Minister Narendra Modi as the yugpurush of this century. "Mahatma Gandhi freed us from the slavery of British through satyagraha and non-violence. India's successful Prime Minister Narendra Modi has taken us to a path where we always wanted to be," Dhankhar said. He was speaking at the birth anniversary celebrations of Jain mystic and philosopher Shrimad Rajchandraji. "I want to tell you one thing. The mahapurush of last century was Mahatma Gandhi. Narendra Modi is the yugpurush of this century," Dhankhar said.

Dhankhar also unveiled a mural of Shrimad Rajchandraji, who was born in Gujarat in 1867 and died in 1901. He is known for his teachings on Jainism and his spiritual guidance to Mahatma Gandhi. "One thing is common between these two great personalities, the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi, and PM Narendra Modi. They have reflected with respect to Shrimad Rajchandraji," Dhankhar said. "Forces opposed to the growth of this nation, forces that do not digest the rise of this country are coming together. Whenever there is something good happening in the country, they get into a different mode. This should not happen," Dhankhar said. "The danger is very big. The countries which you see around (us), their histories are 200 or 500 or 700 years old, (while) our history is 5,000 years old," he said. The Shrimad Rajchandra Mission Dharapur is a global movement that endeavours to enhance the spiritual growth of seekers and benefit the society. With its international headquarters at Dharapur in Gujarat, the Mission has several satyagrah centres, Shrimad Rajchandra Youth Groups and Shrimad Rajchandra Divine touch centres. Shrimad Rajchandraji and Mahatma Gandhi first met in Mumbai in 1891. When the latter returned from England as a young barrister. In the ceremony in Mumbai on Monday, Dhankhar was presented the Janakalyan Hitaishi award by Pujya Gurudev Shri Rakeshji of the Mission for his contribution to social upliftment. "Such was the greatness of Shrimad Rajchandraji, that he inspired both Mahatma Gandhi and Prime Minister Narendra Modi," Dhankhar said. In Monday's event, the Shrimad Rajchandra Mission announced holding two mega multispecialty medical camps in Gadchiroli district in Maharashtra and Jhunjhunu district in Rajasthan, from where Dhankhar hails. Meanwhile, reacting to Dhankhar's remarks on Mahatma Gandhi and Narendra Modi, Bahujan Samaj Party MP Danish Ali wondered on social media platform X, "I would like to ask the Vice President which new era has begun by giving liberty to an MP of the PM's party to abuse a certain community" (PTI)
